Fatal Collision Investigation

Phoenix Police are investigating a collision that has left a 57-year-old man dead in northwest Phoenix.

On May 31st, 2022 around 4:15 p.m., Phoenix Police received a report a collision between a fully marked Phoenix Fire Department Engine and a sedan. Members of the fire crew of the engine rendered life saving measures on the driver of the sedan, and continued care during the transport to the hospital. The driver of the sedan, identified as William Dodd, died from his injuries at the hospital.

Preliminary information during the investigation found that the sedan and fire engine were traveling southbound on 35th Avenue. The fire engine was responding to an emergency call for service and was operating with lights and sirens. The sedan attempted to pass the engine on the right side resulting in a collision. This impact then caused the sedan to lose control and strike a tree. There were no additional injuries sustained during this incident.

At this time, this investigation remains ongoing.
