Despite the efforts of medical personnel, 11-year-old Tamar Boyer and 9-year-old Shevach Boyer have passed away from their injuries. The investigation remains active.

UPDATE: March 3, 2023

Of the above listed victims, Shimone Boyer is the father of the four children. Shimone was pronounced deceased at the scene of the fire. Victims Dov Boyer and Nachman Boyer were both transported to a local hospital where they were pronounced deceased on the day of the incident. The other two juvenile victims were taken to a local hospital in critical condition where they are still receiving medical care.

Tragic Condo Fire Leaves Three Dead, Two Injured

(March 2, 2023) Phoenix police detectives and members of the Phoenix Fire Investigations Taskforce are investigating a fire that claimed the life of a father and two of his children late Wednesday night.

On March 1, 2023, just after 11:00 p.m., Phoenix police officers and Phoenix fire personnel responded to a residential fire near 3200 West Royal Palm Road. When units arrived, firefighters began to work the fire and located five injured people inside. The patients were carried out by firefighters and life saving measures began. An adult male found in the house was pronounced deceased on scene. Four juvenile patients were transported to local hospitals. Two juveniles did not survive their injuries and died at the hospital. The other two juveniles remain in the hospital and are in critical condition.

This is a terrible loss to our community and we understand this kind of tragedy has a tremendous effect on many facets of our community.

The exact cause of the fire remains part of investigation. At this time, there is no evidence to indicate this fire was intentionally started.
