The Phoenix Police Department will be hosting its 9<sup>th</sup> “Missing in Arizona Day” at Memorial Hall at Indian Steele Park.

The event will offer an opportunity for family and friends of missing persons to make detailed police reports of their missing loved ones. Detectives on site will be able to speak one on one with anyone making a report. Detectives will take the report regardless of where in Arizona the loved one is missing from.

Direct relatives of the missing person will also have an opportunity to provide DNA which will be entered in a database only used to identify unknown human remains. Members of our laboratory teams will be on-site to assist with the collection.

At 5:30 pm, a Candlelight Vigil will be held in honor of those missing. Members of our community are encouraged to attend.
