UPDATE September 12, 2022

The victim who suffered life-threatening injuries was identified as Quincy Deon McCoy and was pronounced deceased at the hospital.

After Devon Laterrell Bean was treated for non-life-threatening gunshot injuries, he was interviewed and booked into jail on several charges including 2nd degree murder.

Deon Montrell Bean was interviewed and booked into jail on multiple charges including tampering with physical evidence.

Apartment Shoot-Out Leaves Four Injured

Phoenix Police are investigating an apartment shooting that occurred near 28th Street and Broadway Road involving three adult males. Two males suffered gunshot injuries and the third male left before police arrived. During the gunfire, stray bullets went through an unrelated apartment and injured two people.

Last night at about 8:30 p.m., on September 5, 2022, Phoenix police were called to the area of 28th Street and Broadway Road for a shooting at an apartment complex. Officers arrived and found one adult male suffering from gunshot wounds. He was taken to the hospital with life-threatening-injuries. Moments later, officers were informed an adult male showed up at a local hospital suffering from non-life-threatening gunshot wounds related to the shooting.

Early information indicates three adult male brothers were in an argument. Gunfire was exchanged and two of the males were hit by gunfire. The third male left the scene before police arrived and it is unknown if he is injured.

During the exchange of gunfire, stray bullets went into a nearby apartment and struck one adult male and one juvenile. Both people were taken to the hospital with non-life-threatening injuries.

Detectives responded to take over the investigation. This investigation will take time to process two different scenes. Details about what led up to the shooting or who fired a weapon is still part of the investigation.
