## Shooting Leaves Three Injured

Phoenix Police are investigating a shooting that occurred near 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Vermont Avenue which is located north of Camelback.

Just before 6:00 p.m., on September 28, 2022, Phoenix police were called to the area of 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Vermont Avenue for shots fired. Officers arrived and found evidence of gunfire but no immediate victims. While officers were canvassing the area, they learned two victims arrived at a local hospital with gunshot injuries. Initial information indicates these two victims were present during the shooting. Both victims, an adult male and a teenage female suffered non-life-threatening injuries.

While officers were investigating the shooting, they learned a stray bullet struck an adult male who was across the street on the campus of Grand Canyon University. The male was transported to the hospital with non-life-threatening injuries. At least one building on campus was also struck by stray bullets. No other injuries were reported on campus.

Detectives will be responding to take over the investigation. Information about what led up to the shooting is still under investigation.
