

## **MEDIA ADVISORY OFFICER INVOLVED SHOOTING**

**Date/Time:** August 19, 2020, approximately 1740 hours  
**Location:** 13200 South 48<sup>th</sup> Street  
**IR#:** 2020-1368784  
**Officer:** Triston Hudson, 24-years old, 2 years of service  
**Suspect:** Female, 22 years-old, non-life-threatening gunshot wound

On August 19, 2020 at approximately 1647 hours, Phoenix Police officers responded to a call from Terros, who was at an apartment complex in the area of 13200 S. 48<sup>th</sup> Street. A male had called Terros and reported that his female roommate threatened him with a knife, and also threatened to hurt herself. Both the roommate and Terros personnel waited outside for officers, and the suspect remained inside the apartment.

Officers arrived on scene and attempted to establish communication with the suspect. At some point, they heard what they believed to be a gunshot inside the apartment. The officers began evacuations of neighboring apartments while maintaining cover. Eventually, the suspect stepped out of the apartment with a shotgun in her hands. Several commands were given to drop the gun, but she refused, and raised it in the direction of the officers.

One discharged his handgun, striking the suspect and ending the threat. The officers provided immediate lifesaving measures, and the suspect was transported to the hospital with non-life-threatening injuries. There were no injuries to the officers or other civilians.
